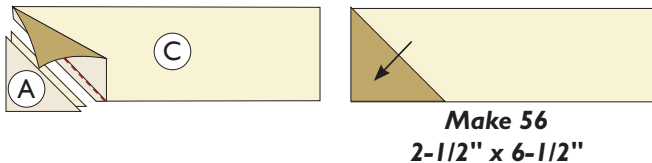
Yardage below is diagrammed on 40" width selvage to selvage. FQs are diagrammed on 20" width.



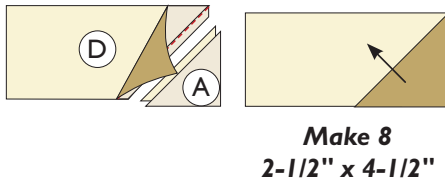
Directions

Stitch & Flip:

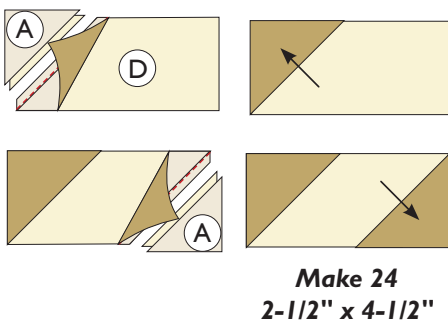
- Place an **A** on the left end of a **C** as shown. Sew alongside the marked line on the side closer to the corner. Trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press in the direction of the arrow.



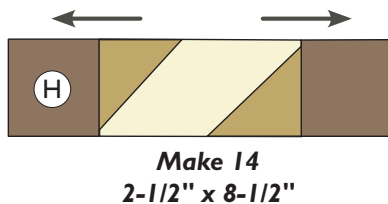
- Repeat the process with an **A** on the right end of a **D** as shown. Press.



- Repeat the process with an **A** on the both ends of a **D** as shown, so the triangles are on the upper left and lower right corners of **D**.

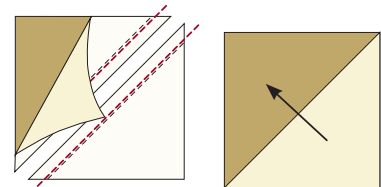
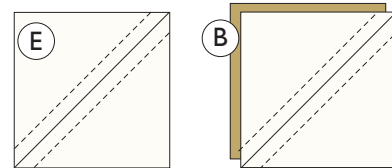


- Sew an **H** to each end of fourteen Step 3 units. Press. Ten Step 3 units will be leftover.



HSTs:

- Draw a diagonal line through all **Es**. Draw a line 1/4" to each side of the center diagonal line. Layer an **E** on a **B**. Stitch slightly to the center of the 1/4" line (dashed) and cut on the center line (solid). Press to **B**.



Make 48 B/E HSTs
4-1/2" square
