#### **Fabrics** Backing: An additional 3-1/2 yards 6640 Luxury 6654 Glitz 3882 Mirage Tea Dyed Tea Dyed Lt Latte 3/4 yd I yd 1/2 yd 6649 Glitz 6651 Glitz 6632 Elegant Bouquet Cream on Cream Lt Latte Dk Brown 2 2-1/4 yds I/2 yd \* I yd

\* For optional bias cut binding, use 3/4 yard.

## Mystery Quilt 2014 Part 3

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#### Pattern Basics

We encourage breaking the rules, but here are a few things you might want to keep in mind:

- Please read through **all** the instructions carefully **before** beginning a project. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern.
- All instructions use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
- All fabrics are sewn right sides together, unless otherwise stated.

#### Common Quilting Acronyms:

FQ = fat quarter (18" x 22") WOFQ = width of fat quarter WOF = width of fabric

LOF = length of fabric

WS = wrong side of fabric RS = right side of fabric HST = half square triangle QST = quarter square triangle ???



Note: All pieces in gray are from Parts I & 2; do not recut!








### Block A Assembly:


12-1/2" unfinished

10. Sew a Part 2, Step 6 HST on each side of a Part 1, Step 5 HST as shown. Press.




Make 12 ~ 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"

11. Sew a Part 1, Step 5 HST on each side of an **L** as shown. Press.



Make 6 ~ 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"


12. Sew a Step 10 unit on the top and bottom of a Step 11 unit as shown. Press.



Make 6 ~ 12-1/2" square

### Block B Assembly:


13. Sew a Part 2, Step 6 HST on each side of a Part 1, Step 5 HST as shown. Press.



Make 12 ~ 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"


**Note:** Block A and Block B are constructed exactly the same except the seams between the units are pressed in the opposite directions, so seams will nest when the blocks are joined.

14. Sew a Part 2, Step 5 HST on each side of an **L** as shown. Press.



Make 6 ~ 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"

15. Sew a Step 13 unit on the top and bottom of a Step 14 unit as shown. Press.



Make 6 ~ 12-1/2" square

## Border Assembly:

16. Sew eight Part 1, Step 1 units together in a row as shown. Press. Sew a G to the end with an A. Press.




Make 4 ~ 2-1/2" x 52-1/2"

17. Sew six Part I, Step I units together in a row as shown. Press. Sew a G to the end with an A. Press.




18. Sew four Part I, Step 4 units alternating with three Part I, Step 3 units. Sew a Part I, Step 2 unit on each end as shown. Press to the **H**s.




Make 2 ~ 2-1/2" x 52-1/2"

19. Sew three Part I, Step 4 units alternating with two Part I, Step 3 units. Sew a Part I, Step 2 unit on each end as shown. Press to the **H**s.




Make 2 ~ 2-1/2" x 40-1/2"

20. Sew a Step 16 row on the top and bottom of a Step 18 row. Press.



Make 2 ~ 6-1/2" x 52-1/2"


21. Sew a Step 17 row on the top and bottom of a Step 19 row. Press.



Make 2 ~ 6-1/2" x 40-1/2"

## Quilt Body Assembly:


- 22. Sew four rows of three blocks, alternating Block A and Block B, so seams will nest. Press.
- 23. Sew the rows together. Press.



36-1/2" x 48-1/2"

#### Add the Borders:

- 24. Measure the length of the quilt through the center, cut two pieced **M**s to that measurement (about 48-1/2"), and sew to the sides. Press.
- 25. Measure the width of the quilt, cut two Ms to that measurement (about 40-1/2"), and sew to the top and bottom. Press.
- 26. Measure the quilt across the width of the quilt. If the pieced border from Step 21 is a little too long, fold in half across the width and trim it to the measurement of the width (about 40-1/2"). Sew a K on each end. Press. Do not sew to quilt yet.
- 27. Measure the length of the quilt through the center. If the pieced border from Step 20 is a little too long, fold in half across the width and trim it to the measurement of the length (about 48-1/2"). Sew a Step 20 pieced border to each side. Press.
- 28. Sew a Step 26 pieced border to the top and bottom. Press.



## Finish the Quilt:

28. Layer backing WS up, batting, and top WS down. Quilt. Bind with a 1/4" seam allowance.
