

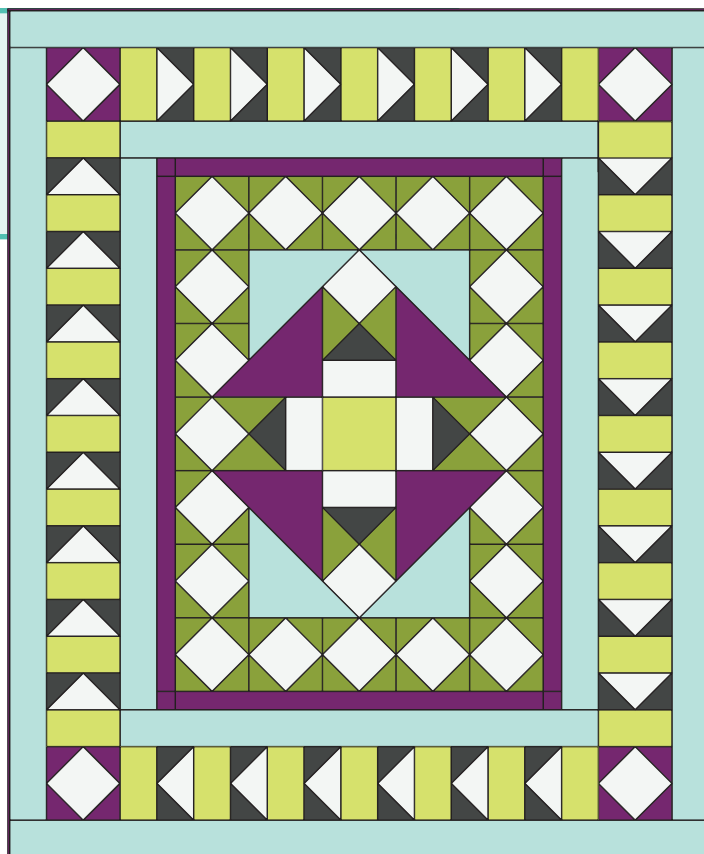
### Pattern Basics

We encourage breaking the rules, but here are a few things you might want to keep in mind:







- Please read through **all** the instructions carefully **before** beginning a project. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern.
- All instructions use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
- All fabrics are sewn right sides together; unless otherwise stated.

### Common Quilting Acronyms:

FQ = fat quarter (18" x 22")      WS = wrong side of fabric  
 WOQ = width of fat quarter      RS = right side of fabric  
 WOF = width of fabric      HST = half square triangle  
 LOF = length of fabric      QST = quarter square triangle

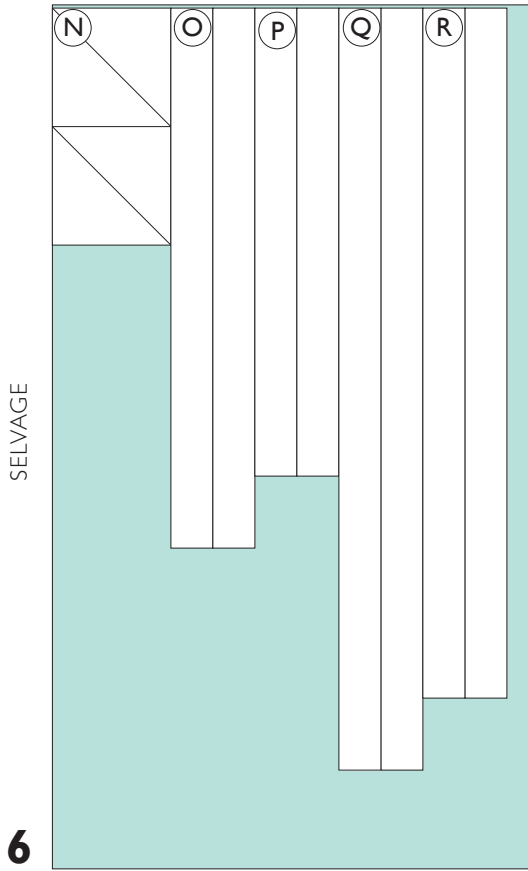
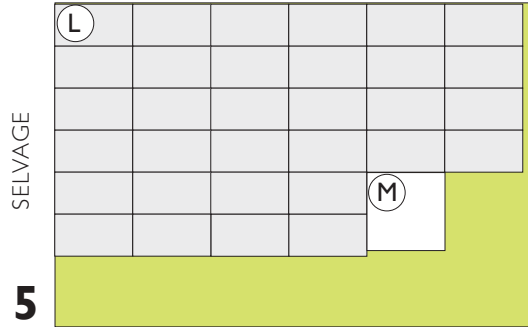
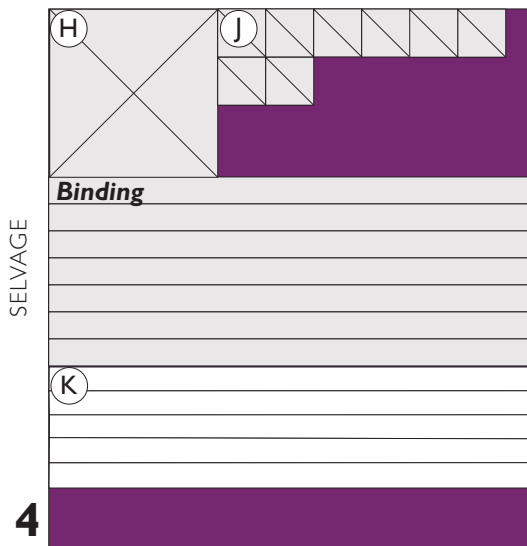
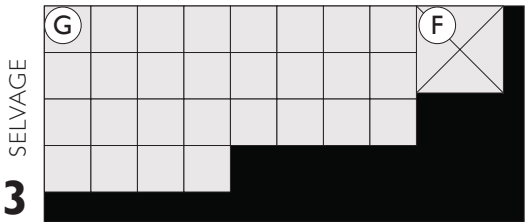
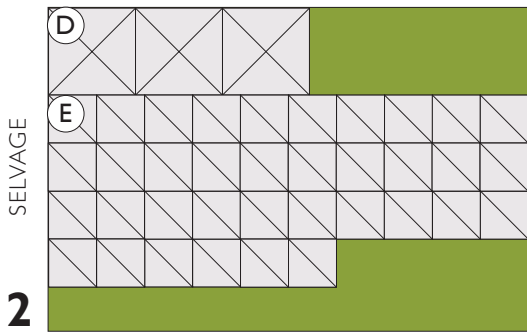
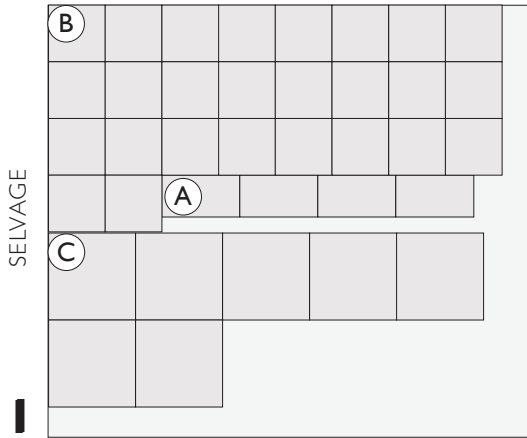
**\*Measure quilt before cutting all borders. For Ks, only four may be needed if WOF (minus selvages) is at least 42-1/2".**

Yardage below is diagrammed on 40" width selvage to selvage. FQs are diagrammed on 20" width.

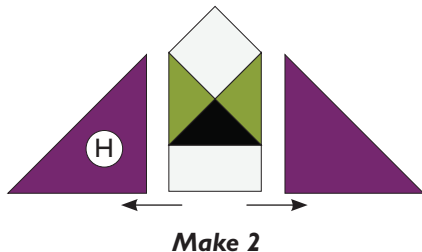

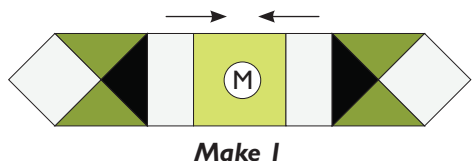
# Directions

## Center Medallion Assembly:

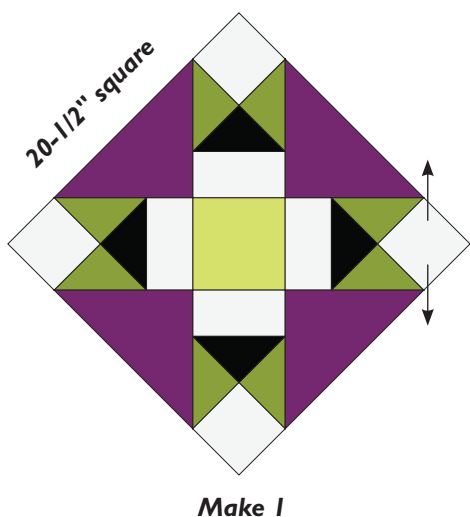
18. Sew an **H** on each side of Step 4 unit with the orientation shown.



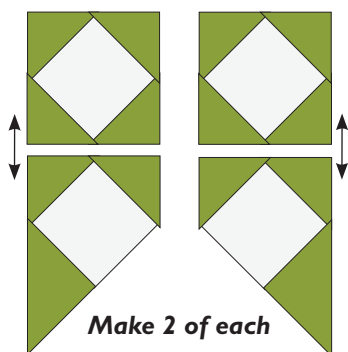
19. Sew a Step 4 unit on each side of an **M**. Press.



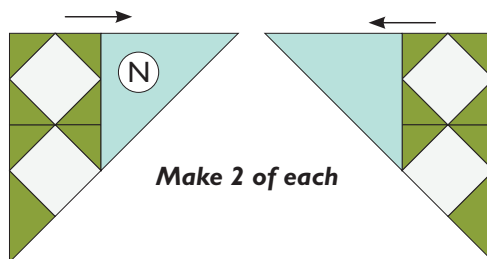
20. Sew a Step 18 unit on the top and bottom of the Step 19 unit. Press.



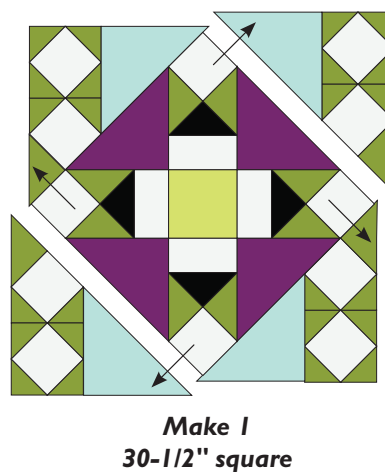
21. Sew a Step 12 unit on the top of the Step 15 units with the orientation shown. Press seams open.



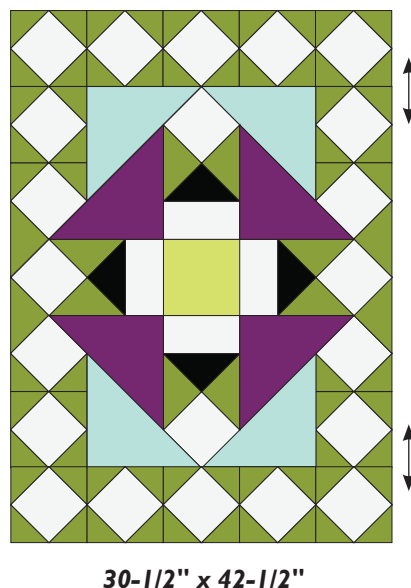
22. Sew an **N** to each of the Step 19 units as shown. Press.



23. Sew the Step 22 units on the Step 20 unit with the orientation shown. Press.



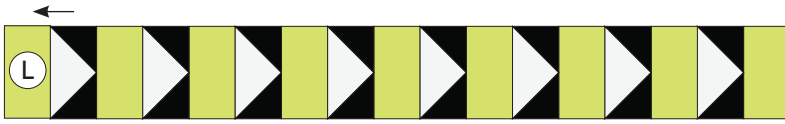
24. Sew a Step 13 unit on the top and bottom of the Step 23 unit as shown. Press seams open.





## Borders Assembly:

25. Add an **L** on the Flying Geese end of the Step 10 units.  
Press.



**Make 2**  
**6-1/2" x 51-1/2"**

26. Add an **L** on the Flying Geese end of the Step 11 units.  
Press. Sew a Step 5 unit on each end. Press.

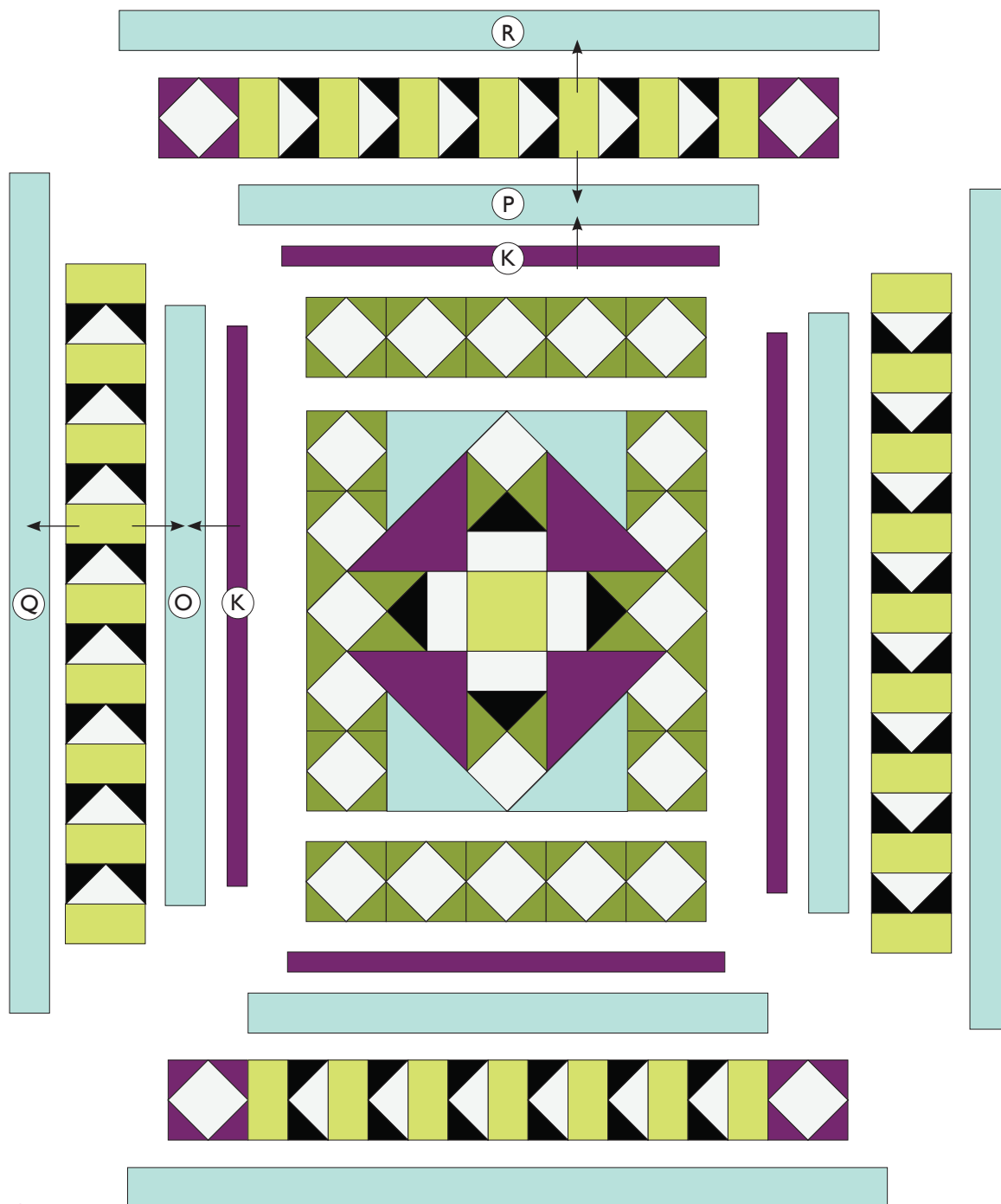

## Quilt Assembly:

27. Cut two 42-1/2" **K** and sew on the sides. *Hint: If the WOF (minus selvages) is less than 42-1/2", sew three **K**s end-to-end, cut two **K**s 42-1/2", and sew on the sides. Press. Cut two 33-1/2" **K**s and sew to the top and bottom. Press.*
28. Sew an **O** to each side. Press. Sew a **P** to the top and bottom. Press.
29. Sew a Step 25 unit to each side. Press to **O**. Sew a Step 26 unit to the top and bottom. Press.
30. Sew a **Q** to each side. Press. Sew an **R** to the top and bottom. Press.



## Finish the Quilt:

**57-1/2" 69-1/2"**

31. Layer backing WS up, batting, and top WS down. Quilt. Bind with a 1/4" seam allowance.
